I remember the moment — it truly hit me that your autism(自闭症) lasted forever. I had already mentally planned our trips up north with the boys. I was going to spend endless hours playing baseball with you — like Grandpa did with me.

When we said goodbye to kindergarten I knew it was real. I spent some time being sad. Now you are 8. You still have no words. We have never had one of those father-son moments I pictured when you were a baby. But I'm learning that's OK. I still have unbelievable things to offer as your dad, even if they weren't the things I originally expected.

You have taught me to be patient. You have taught me that it's OK to be different and to be sad when life doesn't go as planned. You have taught me that it is OK to talk about those feelings and fight for what is right. Stand up and say this is wrong, and encourage others to stand up for you and say the same.

My job on this earth is to create a world for you and other kids like you. Be the voice you don't have, and build the kind of community which I want to see you grow up in. I used to shy a way from contacting people with disabilities or just not consider them. Before you were born, I was so caught up in my own world that I probably

wouldn't have even noticed. Now, I see things differently. I notice. You did that for me. And hope my example will do that for others.

Your mom and I have spent 8 years trying to find your voice. And honestly, we don't know if we ever will. I promise you I will spend my life keeping you safe and making this world better for you.

Once flying globally, University of Vermont music professor David Feurzeig is demonstrating how locals can fight climate change and promote community in his “Play Every Town Project”.

Feurzeig once prided himself on attending musical festivals around the world. “For academic musicians,” he notes on his website, “there are motivations to fly, fly, fly. The farther the performance, the more reputation and promotion.”

Then Feurzeig thought about how such carbon-intensive travel contributes to the climate crisis. “Touring needs to change rapidly,” he said, “if we are to maintain a livable world.” That’s why the 58-year-old has given up flying globally and instead relies on his solar-powered electric vehicle and public transportation for his current project.

Feurzeig is aiming to perform a free concert in every one of Vermont's 252 cities and towns, all while promoting local and state environmental causes. Starting in May 2022 in the state's largest city of Burlington, the pianist has shared his idea at more than 50 performances. Feurzeig estimates that the project will last until the end of the decade to complete.

The pianist and his stage manager travel to events in most any weather. Consider the one in Warren, just after last July's historic statewide flooding. "On the recording of the concert, you can hear the stream racing by," he said. "And I've played on the smokiest day in Vermont history, the wettest day in Vermont history, the hottest November day in Vermont history. All these things are becoming worse and more and more frequent."

So far, the project has raised more than \$17,000 in donations for local and state environmental groups. "I want to support local efforts that protect our environment and bring people together. Music can spark change, one town at a time," he said. Feurzeig's concert journey blends artistic passion with climate action, proving local green concerts echo louder than distant music festivals.

二、单项选择

11. A

【详解】考查动词词义辨析。句意：实际上，那些网络评论并不能代表大家对你作品的看法，所以你不必把这些评论看得太当回事。A. represent 代表，表示；B. identify 认出，识别；C. monitor 监视，监控；D. honor 尊敬。根据主语“those online comments(那些网上的评论)”以及宾语“everyone’s opinion of your work(每个人对你作品的看法)”可推知，这里表达“网上的评论不代表每个人的看法”含义，因此这里应是“represent”。故选 A 项。

12. C

【详解】考查动词词义辨析。句意：女儿上大学已有数周，短暂想家后，她似乎已逐渐适应。A. ensuring 确保；B. resolving 解决，决心；C. adjusting 适应；D. forgiving 原谅。女儿刚上大学，可能有段时间想家，但之后应该适应了，所以空格处应该填一个表示适应的词。adjusting well 符合句意，最贴切。故选 C。

13. C

【详解】考查副词。句意：团队合作不会在工作场所或学校自然发生，它需要培训。A. natural 自然的(adj.); B. nature 自然(n.); C. naturally 自然地(adv.); D. naturalist 自然主义者。此处修饰动词 happen，应用副词 naturally“自然地”，作状语。故选 C 项。

14. D

【详解】考查动词短语辨析。句意：——如果火灾发生，每个人都知道该怎么做吗？——是的。他们已经接受过很多次培训了。A. breaks down 出故障，分解；B. breaks in 闯入，打断；C. breaks up 解散，破碎，分手；D. breaks out 爆发，突然发生。根据上文“a fire”以及语境可知，空处表示火灾突然发生的情况，D 选项“breaks out”符合句意。故选 D。

15. C

【详解】考查代词。句意：学习是一段终生的旅程，因为它每天都给我们带来新的东西。A. our 是形容词性物主代词，意为“我们的”，后需接名词；B. ours 是名词性物主代词，意为“我们的”，相当于“our + 名词”；C. us 是人称代词宾格，意为“我们”，在句中作宾语；D. we 是人称代词主格，意为“我们”，在句中作主语。brings 是从句谓语动词，其后接人称代词宾格作宾语，所以用 us。故选 C。

16. A

【详解】考查非谓语动词。句意：我们学校有许多古树，每棵都可以追溯到大约 100 年前。“each _____ about 100 years ago”是独立主格结构，动词短语 date from 和 date back to 意为“追溯到”，是非谓语动词，与其逻辑主语 each 之间为主动关系，所以用现在分词形式。故选 A。

17. A

【详解】考查名词词义辨析。句意：最后但并非最不重要的是，每个人都应该承担充分利用水的责任。A. responsibility 责任；B. achievement 成就；C. emotion 情绪；D. gratitude 感激。根据“to make full use of water”可知，充分利用水是每个人应该承担的“责任”。故选 A。

18. C

【详解】考查动词词义辨析。句意：为了防止环境恶化，政府提出了新的政策来限制不可再生能源的使用，敦促工业采用更清洁的替代能源。A. multiply 使增加，使繁殖；B. estimate 估计，评估；C. restrict 限制，约束；D. explode 使爆炸，爆发。根据“To prevent the environment worsening”以及“urging industries to adopt cleaner alternatives instead”可知，政府是要对不可再生能源的使用进行“限制”。故选 C 项。

19. A

【详解】考查动词词义辨析。句意：经过数周的研究和起草，学生们被建议在提交论文前彻底润色他们的论文，重点是精炼语言并确保逻辑流畅。A. polish 润色，使完美；B. dominate 支配，控制；C. resemble 类似，像；D. associate 联想，联系。根据“focusing on refining the language and ensuring logical flow”可知，这里是在提交论文前要对论文进行润色，使语言更精炼，逻辑更流畅，polish 符合语境。故选 A 项。

20. C

【详解】考查动词词义辨析。句意：我们学生应该珍惜宝贵的时间，不遗余力地用现代科学技术武装自己。A. represent 代表；B. escape 逃离；C. equip 装备，使具备；D. establish 建立。根据“ourselves with modern science and technology”可知，此处表示用现代科学技术来武装自己，equip sb. with sth. 是固定搭配，意为“用某物装备某人”。故选 C。

21. 细节理解题。第一个小标题“**Golden Gate Bridge, USA**”下“the Golden Gate Bridge was built in the 1930s(金门大桥建于上世纪 30 年代)”表明金门大桥建于上世纪 30 年代，使其几乎有一个世纪的历史。故选 D 项。

22. 细节理解题。第二个小标题“**Banff National Park, Canada**”下“Home to alpine peaks, glacial lakes, and the famous Icefields Parkway scenic drive, Banff is a heaven for lovers of natural beauty and adventure.(班夫国家公园拥有高山峰、冰川湖泊和著名的冰原公路风景道，是自然美景和冒险爱好者的天堂。)”和第三个小标题“**Balboa Park, USA**”下“The park is full of history, architecture, art, and beautiful nature.(这个公园充满了历史、建筑、艺术和美丽的自然风景。)”表明班夫国家公园和巴尔博亚公园都以其充满令人赞叹的自然之美而闻名，故选 A 项。

23. 细节理解题。第四个小标题“**The Great Pyramid of Giza, Egypt**”下“As the oldest of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, and the only one that still remains well-preserved today, the Great Pyramid of Giza is a truly fantastic sight.(作为世界七大古迹中最古老的建筑，也是仅存并保存完好的一个，吉萨大金字塔是一个真正的奇观。)”表明吉萨金字塔被认为是真正的奇迹，因为它是七大古代世界奇迹中最古老的建筑且保存完好。所以吉萨大金字塔的真正奇妙之处它的历史和保护。故选 D 项。

【导语】这是一篇应用文。本文是一篇父亲写给自闭症儿子的信，信中充满关爱;作者说从儿子那里学到了如何与残疾人相处、如何更好地与儿子相处，信最后，作者说虽不知道儿子是否能说话，但他会全力保护儿子。

24. 推理判断题。由倒数第二段中的句子“I used to shy away from contacting people with disabilities or just not consider them.(我过去常常回避与残疾人接触，或者根本不考虑他们。)”和“Before you were born, I was so caught up in my own world that I probably wouldn’t have even noticed. Now, I see things differently. I notice.(在你出生之前，我太沉迷于自己的世界了，我可能都没有注意到。现在，我的看法不同了。我注意到了)”可知，作者在儿子出生之前常回避与残疾人接触，或者干脆不考虑他们，现在作者的看法不同了，他注意到了残疾人，所以作者改变了对残疾人的看法。故选 C。

25. 推理判断题。由第三段的句子“You have taught me to be patient. 【导语】这是一篇记叙文，文章主要讲述了佛蒙特大学音乐教授 David Feurzeig 为应对气候危机，放弃全球飞行，通过 “Play Every Town Project”，在佛蒙特州的各个城镇举办免费音乐会，推动当地环保事业，将艺术热情与气候行动相结合的故事。

27. 细节理解题。根据第三段“Then Feurzeig thought about how such carbon-intensive travel contributes to the climate crisis. “Touring needs to change rapidly,” he said, “if we are to maintain a livable world.” That’s why the 58-year-old has given up flying globally (然后 Feurzeig 思考这种高碳排的旅行是如何加剧气候危机的。他说: “如果我们要维持一个宜居的世界，巡回演出需要迅速改变”这就是为什么这位 58 岁的教授放弃了全球飞行)”可知，Feurzeig 因为担心碳足迹对气候的影响而放弃全球飞行。故选 A。

32. 根据空前“About 2.5-3 L of pure water will make your skin shining, and it also helps with digestion (消化).(大约 2.5-3 升的纯净水会让你的皮肤发亮，也有助于消化)”可知，上文提到喝水的好处。选项 C “I have a super pretty water bottle(我有一个超级漂亮的水瓶)”中的“water bottle”正是空后“which contains about 500 ml of water.(里面含有大约 500 毫升的水)”中的“which”所指代的内容。故选 C。

33. 空处为小标题，为本段主要内容。根据下文“I am lucky in a way that I simply love the taste of fruits and vegetables.
